MEDIASET ESPAÑA ACQUIRES BROADCASTING RIGHTS OF 25 FREE TO AIR GAMES IN FIFA WORLD CUP BRAZIL 2014 TM



- Mediaset Sport, through Telecinco, Cuatro and Energy, will offer 25 free to air games of the championship which will take place in Brazil between the 12th of June and the 13th of July 2014, among which, all of the Spanish team's games.
- Beforehand, they will broadcast the classification clashes which the Spanish team will play against Finland (6th September) Belarus (11th October) and Georgia (15th October), the FIFA Confederations Cup Brazil 2013 and all friendlies in preparation for the World Cup.
- Mediaset Españas policy for the adquisition of broadcasting rights is its crowning jewel positioning them as the audiovisual group with the best sporting offer in the Spanish market
