

"El Niño" GETS THE BEST PREMIERE OF THE YEAR OF A SPANISH FILM WITH OVER 2.9 MILLION EURO BOX OFFICE IN ITS FIRST WEEKEND

The film "El Niño" has achieved in its first weekend, grossed, 2.9 million euro, making it the biggest opening of the year of a Spanish film after overcoming the successful launch of "**8 Apellidos vascos**" most-watched Spanish film in history.

"El Niño" is number one at the box office and beats all other films including the premieres scheduled for the weekend and hit "**Lucy**" in its second week in theaters.
